During the past two months, we have worked closely with schools in Malaysia and Taiwan to help these students explore opportunities for further education.



During the summer, we also hosted a special Asian MK High School Camp, inviting a professional care team to minister to these teenagers. The camp focused on helping them build emotional resilience, explore educational and career pathways, and develop healthy support networks.
