Our grace from the Lord:**1. Business-lead Ministry Team:**

The team of co-workers continues to expand. It regularly assesses the current business-lead missionary projects and accompanies and counsels the business-lead missionaries. It has provided four trainings with business-lead ministry courses and is building a business-lead ministry resource repository to fully utilize the various resources from the Kingdom of God.

2. Monday Prayer Meeting:

It has been stable with an increase in the number of people. Although we often experience the pressure of empathy with the missionaries, we also experience the joy when prayers are answered. Thank you to Pastor James Hudson Taylor IV for sharing "How to Pray for Missionaries" with us last week. We have benefited a lot!

3. Expenses supported:

In the past two months, we have received a lot of support for the education and medical insurance expenses of our children.

4. Covid-19 patients healed:

Several missionaries in the field have been infected by Covid-19, and the co-workers at the rear have strengthened their prayers and caring. With the mercy of the Lord, they have been healed.

5. The evacuation of workers from country A:

A civil war broke out in country A, and the T organization took over the power. The emergency team arranged an evacuation plan in advance, and the co-workers evacuated smoothly. Many people in country A fled, suffering and wandering, like sheep without a shepherd. We have started a refugee ministry, providing living expenses and living care for refugees, sharing good news, and discipleship training for those who have already believed.

6. New directors:

We have found two very good new directors. We believe that our team will become stronger and stronger and more usable by the Lord.

7. Cross-cultural Training Center:

Students attending classes while working and serving on weekends have completed one month of intensive training, and went out for internships and preaching on foot. Everything is going well, and the online course is about to start.

Our current needs:

1. Cost: Due to the pandemic, many missionaries' children cannot attend classes physically and can only participate in online full-time American-style education. This cost is more than double our original budget, so we ask the Lord to prepare for it. In addition, many people in country A have fled to border countries. We must seize the opportunity to join the ministry of the refugee that has just come out of country A, and ask the Lord to provide all the needs of this ministry.

2. Prayer: Every worker is what we value most, and every ministry is full of challenges. What we can do for them is to pray without ceasing, and we hope that more people will join us in our prayers.
