Thank you for your continuous support and care for GIU. We are very pleased to share with you the fruitful results of the co-workers' retreat held in Houston from September 11th to 14th, as well as the prospects for future ministries.

I. United in Mission for the Glory of God's Kingdom:

We joined hands with GIV (Galilee International Ventures) to hold this co-workers' retreat. More than 30 board of directors, colleagues and mentors from different regions and backgrounds gathered together. The theme focused on "Hand in Mission in Christ", emphasizing that although we possess different gifts, backgrounds, languages and cultures, we are still united in Christ because of our common faith, and have the same mission of glorifying God and expanding the kingdom of God.

- Sharing Resources, United Together: We firmly believe that all resources come from God and should be shared with each other. In Christ we do away with comparison and competition. In a short period of time, they established more than 50 small churches, and even witch doctors and university professors were moved by God's love. Then, he began to train these new believers and send them to start new churches. Brother B's sharing around the United States has deeply impressed audiences, and I believe that more people will join the cross-cultural missionary work as a result. Brother B's testimony shows us the power of God and ignites our passion for cross-cultural missions.
