



Dear Mission Partners, peace be with you!

Thank you for your long-standing support, care, and prayers. This summer break has been filled with grace, and we would like to share it with you.

I. Missionary Kids (MK) High School Camp: In early July, around 30 missionary kids and several parents from over 10 countries gathered in Malaysia for the MK High School Camp. A wonderful team of teachers from Kaohsiung (Gaoxiong), Taiwan, accompanied the children with creative program designs and tireless service.

The youth learned about self-management, spiritual disciplines, choosing college majors, and discovering their calling. They also experienced an urban adventure and observed a local youth gathering. Most touching of all were the two nights of worship: God deeply touched the youth's hearts as they knelt, wept, confessed their sins, were filled with the Holy Spirit, and dedicated themselves to the Lord.

After worship, they shared their encounters with God through tears. It was clear that God showed extraordinary favor to them, bringing fruits far beyond our expectations. Since returning home, many of the youth have maintained a consistent devotion life, and some have even led their families in home worship. Missionary kids have pure hearts alongside a solid foundation in faith and ministry—investing in them is truly wise. We hope to see more second-generation Chinese missionaries rise up.



II. Training: Training is the key to mission work and a ministry that GIU places a significant importance to. Every year, we launch new missionary training schools and local discipleship training schools in various mission fields. Batch after batch of students complete their training, and new students are welcomed during the summer break.

We not only equip Chinese missionaries but also empower local co-workers to become missionaries, hoping that God will use Galilee to train and support more cross-cultural missionaries.

III. Chinese Class for Missionary Kids: The Chinese class for missionary kids will start at the end of August. To give the next generation a broader path of ministry in the future, we hope to help them continue learning Chinese. GIU has partnered with San Diego Grace School to provide professional Chinese education at the most favorable rate. The courses will officially begin at the end of August.

IV. Flash Floods and Mudslides in Nepal: Disaster Situation and Relief: On August 26, severe flash floods and mudslides struck northern Nepal near the Tibetan border, destroying villages and burying homes. Many families are currently enduring immense suffering. We are grateful that all local co-workers our missionaries work with have been safely evacuated.

V. Please Pray for Our Next Steps:

1. Galilee's Call for Nepal Disaster Relief Fundraising and Prayer Support: Pray that the Lord will protect relief efforts, comfort affected families, and open doors for the Gospel; pray also that God will provide emergency supply kits and fulfill all relief needs.

2. GIU Board and Staff Team Retreat: Held in Houston this September. Pray that God will guide us to seek His heart through prayer, renew our team, and direct our future ministry.

3. Nepal Missionary Sharing and Mobilization: A missionary from Nepal will share across the United States. Pray that God uses their testimonies to inspire more churches to actively engage in global missions.

4. Funding Needs for the New Year: Pray for the financial needs of the new year—including missionary insurance, children's education, and various ministry expenses. Pray that God provides abundantly and touches the hearts of more brothers and sisters to become our prayer warriors and financial partners.

Thank you for walking alongside us every step of the way. Behind every ministry, there is your prayer, offering, and support. May we continue to look to God together and see Him do His good will among the next generation, in every mission field, and among all nations.
