Beloved fellow workers and families: Greetings!

Thank you for your long prayers and support for the Galilee Mission! We are grateful before the Lord and we remember you. These two months have been also full of the Lord's grace, experience, challenges and wins.

1. The grace we have received

1) Most of the field worker family members we serve are safe, and the service in the fields has become gradually stable. But some workers in the seriously infected pandemic areas still lack sufficient financial and medical resources. Apart from worries, we can only pray. A co-worker was infected with the covid-19 virus and the whole family had a fever. They took medicine and inhaled oxygen at home, while the family members at the rear have prayed for them without ceasing. After a week they became negative, still recovering. Some other families were also sick, such as colds, fevers, hearing loss, hives..., all have been healed by the Lord's mercy.

2) For the stability of the field workers, we have a group of co-workers praying every Monday night US East Coast 8:00 to 9:00. They gather online, first listen to the field workers to share, then pray urgently in one accord for those field family members, providing the largest support and serve. We hope that more people can participate in this prayer continuously. Please contact us if you are willing.

3) Special thanks to our care team, business advocacy groups and all co-workers of the administrative team, for their every bit of faithful service in one accord, doing the best to offer, so that the whole Galilee team can often gain breakthroughs, and the field worker families can serve joyfully.

4) We attach great importance to the education of missionaries' children. There are now two educational platforms to provide for our children's education, and we even have started full-time online learning. Our children's education expense coverage has made a big breakthrough.

2. Please continue to commemorate us

1) Pray for the physical and mental health of the field workers, a safe environment, and harmony in family relations. Pray that they can serve healthily and efficiently with less stress.

2) We want to mobilize and connect more churches to walk on the missionary road. Pray to the Lord for more co-workers to participate in our mobilization team and care team.

3) Particularly important is the field workers' health insurance coverage. Our budget is \$ 60,000, and the current gap is still very big, and we pray that the Lord will prepare.
